

1999/210 F. Elections to subsidiary and related bodies of the Economic and Social Council, nominations, appointments and confirmation of representatives on functional commissions⁹⁸

At its 50th and 51st plenary meetings, on 15 November and 16 December 1999, the Economic and Social Council took the following action with regard to vacancies in its subsidiary and related bodies:

Elections postponed from previous sessions

EXECUTIVE BOARD OF THE WORLD FOOD PROGRAMME

Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 53/223 of 7 April 1999, which provided for a new distribution of seats on the Board, the Council elected FRANCE, HUNGARY, IRAN (ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF), JAPAN, MEXICO and SWAZILAND for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2000.

The Council elected NORWAY to assume the term of office of DENMARK for a term beginning on 1 January 2000 and expiring on 31 December 2001.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL WORKING GROUP OF EXPERTS ON INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS OF ACCOUNTING AND REPORTING

The Council elected FRANCE and MALTA for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2000.
